Declaration of Ownership on Behalf of a Limited Partnership

- Notes:
1. This form is to be completed by the General Partner for the Limited Partnership.
 2. Please ensure that you complete all three parts of this form.
 3. Complete Part 2 by ticking the appropriate boxes and following the directions given.
 4. After completion of Part 3, send this form, together with the documents specified in that Part and Registry Advice Note no 5 to Isle of Man Ship Registry.
 5. A ship is entitled to be registered if 33 of the 64 shares are legally and beneficially owned by qualified persons (defined in Registry Advice note No 2. Joint owners of a share must all be qualified persons for that share to count towards the 33 shares required.
 6. If the vessel is currently registered abroad you must take all reasonable steps to remove the vessel from the foreign register before completing registration under the above Act. Failure to comply with this requirement can result in a fine.

The Department must be kept informed of all changes of representative Person and Manager including changes in name, address and new appointments.
