- Document of Compliance for carrying Harmful substances (Marine pollutants)
- Relevant documents and information corresponding to Harmful substances are carried on board
- Emergency procedures and crew awareness in event of an inciodent involving Harmful substances (Marine pollutants) are in place
- Ensure that Harmful substances (Marine pollutants) are marked, stowed and secured appropriately
