Isle of Man Issued Certificates – Change of Appearance

The Isle of Man Ship Registry (IOMSR) wishes to advise relevant parties of a forthcoming change to the appearance of certain IOMSR certificates. IOMSR certificates that are currently issued on paper that is watermarked with the Isle of Man Government Crest and a coloured border will be printed on plain paper only with effect from 1st August 2018. The format and content of the certificates will remain unchanged.

This change will apply to new certificates only, therefore certificates of the current appearance may remain in circulation for a period of up to five years from 1st August 2018.

Among the certificates that will now be issued on plain paper are:

- DOC Certificate
- MLC Certificate (including DMLC Parts I & II)
- ISPS Certificate
- YCC Certificate
- Minimum Safe Manning Document
- STCW Endorsement
- Nairobi Wreck Certificate
- Bunker Certificate
- CLC Certificate
- CSR
- Passenger Ship Safety Certificate
- HSC Safety Certificate
- HSC Permit to Operate
- HSC Type Rating Certificate
- Exemption Certificate
- Large Fishing Vessel Certificate
- Small Fishing Vessel Certificate
- MODU Certificate
