**EXEMPTION OF PLEASURE CRAFT REGISTERED UNDER
THE "SMALL SHIPS REGISTER" FROM THE REQUIREMENT
TO REGISTER UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE
REGISTRATION OF PLEASURE CRAFT ACT 1974**

The former Isle of Man Harbour Board made the Registration of Pleasure Craft (Exemption) 1985 on the 24th July 1985, by virtue of which any pleasure craft, which is already registered on the Small Ships Register maintained by the Isle of Man Ship Registry (Department of Economic Development), is now exempted from the requirement to register in accordance with the provisions of the Registration of Pleasure Craft Act 1974. This Exemption will thus avoid any unnecessary duplication of registration requirements.

It is to be noted that the Pleasure Craft Register is maintained by the Harbour Masters Division of the Department of Transport.
